

Critical Care Recovery Center (CCRC)

Patients may have problems physically, emotionally and/or cognitively. Using all necessary resources (ranging from medication to therapy to mental health services, etc.), this program can assist ICU patients and their families with all of their recovery needs in one place.

Aging Brain Care Program

The Eskenazi Health Aging Brain Care program diagnoses and treats individuals experiencing cognitive impairment, specifically for older patients with memory or depression problems. Established in 2008, this one-of-a-kind center combines research and treatment facilities, resulting in the rapid translation of research discoveries into clinical practice. Working closely with the patient's primary care provider, the care team develops a personal treatment plan for each patient that includes medications as well as non-drug treatments to improve the quality of life for patients and caregivers.
